## **1 CORINTHIANS 12**

Apostle (vs 28).	A group of men selected during the period of time when the Church was being established, along with the New Testament Scriptures. These men were entrusted with sign gifts to prove that their authority was from God.
Prophecy (vs 28)	The person with this gift will open the Bible and proclaim what God has said about the future for the purpose of edifying, exhorting, and comforting the hearers (1 Cor. 14:3). There are no new revelations given today. All prophecy can be found in the Bible.
Teachers (vs 28)	These are Christians who have an amazing ability to communicate God's truth to people so they can more easily understand it and apply it to their lives. Teachers expound the Scriptures, developing the themes, using illustrations, expanding and explaining as needed.
