# WHAT TO DO WITH MONEY.

#### 1. PAY YOUR BILLS.

- a. First Timothy 5:8. Provide for your own family.
  - i. A Christian man who does NOT pay his own way is worse than an infidel.
    - 1. Don't get married if you can't support a wife.
    - 2. Don't have children if you can't afford it.
      - a. It is not anybody else's responsibility to take care of them, but yours.

# b. Psalm 37:21. Repay your debts.

- i. It is a wicked thing to borrow money and not repay it.
  - 1. If the government has provided a way to make it legal to escape your obligations, that doesn't make it right.
  - 2. When you loan somebody some money and they neglect to repay YOU, it is easier to SEE that it's not right. (Step into the shoes of the lender).

## c. Proverbs 22:7. Be accountable to the lender.

- i. If you borrow money, it is important to keep in mind that you are servant to the lender.
  - 1. If you forget that you're servant to the lender, you'll continue to ADD to your debt until it is unmanageable.
    - a. Take the example of the American deficit. That national debt is beyond recovery. **Psalm 9:17** says every nation that forgets God will be turned into hell.
  - 2. As soon as you have money to repay a loan (large or small), pay it back.
    - a. Don't take advantage of the lender and make them wait. Live within a tighter budget so you can return the loan quickly.

- 3. If you buy a house on credit, make CERTAIN that you will have no difficulty making the payments. It's not your house until the final payment is made.
  - a. Whatever you purchase on credit, only buy what you can truly afford. If you have a nice car, but your children are hungry, you are worse than an infidel.
- d. Matthew 22:15-22. Pay your taxes.
  - i. If you expect to enjoy the services that your nation provides, you'll have to pay taxes.
    - 1. If you don't pay taxes, you'll be taken to court where you will lose your testimony over money.
      - a. Christians should not be seen as lawbreakers.
- e. Romans 13:1-7. Pay whatever is required by the governing body of your society.
  - i. Don't get preoccupied with earthly battles to increase your comfort level.
    - 1. Remember that the most important thing you ought to do is tell people about the Lord Jesus Christ. You've only got a short amount of time on this earth to accomplish that. Don't waste any time on worldly causes.

#### 2. SAVE FOR YOUR FAMILY.

- a. Luke 19:22-23. Use legally established means of increasing your money.
  - i. The Lord Jesus approved of financial establishments that reward you for depositing your money with them.
    - 1. He rebuked a man for not depositing his money and collecting interest.
- b. 2 Corinthians 12:14. Parents ought to save money for their children.
- c. Proverbs 13:22. A good man will leave an inheritance for his children.
