WHAT TO DO WITH MONEY (cont.) Give To God

16 August 2013

REASONS FOR GIVING:

I. 2 Corinthians 9:5-8

- a. Because it takes money to minister to the saints (verse 1).
 - i. Therefore, prepare in advance (vs. 5) to give bountifully (generously).
- b. Because you reap what you sow (verse 6).
- c. Because is reveals your heart condition (verse 7).
 - i. People gladly spend money on the object of their affection (husband, wife, child).
 - ii. What you give reveals the level of affection you have for your Lord.
 - iii. Giving is expected of "every man" (vs. 7), but the amount is left up to each person.
- d. Because God loves a cheerful giver; one who gives because they love and appreciate Him (vs. 7)
- e. Because when you give to "every good work," God will give you grace and provision to give more (vs. 8).

II. 1 Corinthians 9:6-17

- a. Because God said the one who *willingly* (vs. 17) ministers spiritual things to others should be compensated by their carnal things. (verse 11).
 - i. Willingly: If you won't serve the Lord for free, you shouldn't be serving the Lord for pay.
- b. So that a minister is available to meet the spiritual needs of the people when the time comes that they have a need. (A principle established in the Old Testament and New Testament).
- c. Because those who are willing to go to the mission field can't go without support.
 - i. If you're not willing to go, be willing to give so others can go.

III. 1 Corinthians 16:1-3

- a. Because it is expected that every believer is going to give (vs. 1) when they assemble (vs. 2).
 - i. It is expected that you will be willing to give liberally (generously, freely) for the sake of the God you love (vs. 3).

IV. Romans 15:26

- a. It is my duty to minister carnal things to those from whom I have benefited in spiritual things.
- **V.** Because when you give to the work of God (with right motives), God promises to give it back.
 - a. Luke 6:38
 - b. Galatians 6:7
 - c. Ecclesiastes 11:1-2
 - i. It is an investment.

VI. Haggai 1:3-9

- a. Because if we devote all our money only to selfish things, our money be diminished (reduced) and we'll struggle to make ends meet.
- b. Because the Lord takes pleasure in our giving to the work of the Lord (vs. 8).

VII. Genesis 14:18-20

a. Bible precedent: the first time a tithe was given, it was given out of appreciation for what God had done.
