Read Psalm 127

- Two pictures are presented: building and battling.
 - Both are vain unless the Lord is the one accomplishing the work.
- Your Christian life will include building something that counts for God. Make a difference in your life (**Jude 1:22**).
 - When you do that, it will attract opposition and introduce new battles. (Nehemiah 4:16-18).
 - When you start building, prepare for battles. Make sure that what you're building is truly the work of God.
 - Building and battling go together. Building must always come first (Lk 14:27-33).
- God wants you to build your life according to His guidance and His direction (Prov 3:5-6).
 - If you try to direct your own life, it will amount to nothing.
 - God is not impressed with our attempts to build our own lives (Isaiah 66:1, Acts 7:49-50).
 - God is more interested in the humble person who lives their life according to His word (Isaiah 66:2).

- A. The Blueprint is the Word of God (2Timothy 3:16-17)
- **B.** The Foundation is Jesus Christ (1Corinthians 3:11)
- C. The Building is our Life and Works (Matthew 7:24-27)

- A. He Chooses the House to be Built (John 15:16)
- B. He Guides the Construction of the House (John 15:1-6) "Without me ye can do nothing."
- C. He Assures the Completion of the House (Philippians 1:6; Hebrews 12:2)

III. WE ARE THE LABORERS (1Corinthians 3:9-10)

- A. We Must Seek the Will of the Builder (Acts 9:6) "Lord, what wilt thou have me to do?"
- B. We Must Obey the Instructions of the Builder (<u>Psalms 143:10</u>; Proverbs 3:5-6)
- C. We Must Trust the Wisdom of the Builder (1Thessalonians 5:24) "Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it."
