Know the Holy Scriptures

2 Timothy 3:15-17

- Eph 6:17 "And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God."
- Php 2:16 "...holding forth the word of life."
- **Psa 1:2** The blessed man's "*delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night*."
 - I. <u>Scripture is Provided by God (v. 16)</u>
 - *"all scripture is GIVEN by inspiration of GOD."*
 - James 1:17, scripture is a gift from God.
 - A. <u>Its Scope (range, extent) -- All Scripture</u>.
 - B. <u>Its Sense</u> -- Is given
 - $\circ~$ Neh. 8:8 "So they read in the book in the law of God distinctly, and gave the sense, and caused them to understand the reading."
 - "Is given" That is present tense. God is still keeping His Book pure and true.
 - C. <u>Its Spirit</u> By Inspiration
 - God's Spirit is in His written words.
 - 2 Pet. 1:19 God's written words are reliable than eyewitness testimonies.
 - II. <u>Scripture is Purified by God</u> (v. 15 "the holy scriptures")
 - Psalm 12:6 "The words of the LORD ARE pure words." Present tense.
 - A. <u>Purified Seven Times</u> (Psalms 12:6-7)
 - Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek, Old Syriac, German, Old Latin, English 1611 Version.
 - Tyndales, Matthew's, Coverdale's, The Great Bible, The Geneva Bible, The Bishop's Bible, the King James Bible.
 - Purified Seven Times in Seven Languages and then seven times in the English.
 - B. <u>Pure in Preservation</u> (Psalms 12:6-7)
 - God promised to keep and preserve His words forever (vs 7).
 - C. <u>Pure in Every Word</u> (Proverbs 30:5-6)

III. <u>Scripture is to be Pursued by Man</u> (v. 15)

- Timothy pursued the scriptures since childhood.
- A. <u>God Has Given Them</u> (v. 16)

- B. <u>We May Know Them</u> (v. 15; 2 Timothy 2:15)
 - *"From a CHILD thou hast known the holy scriptures."* There is no excuse for not gaining understanding of God's word. See the excuses in Isaiah 29:11-12.

IV. <u>Scripture Points the Way to Salvation</u> (v. 15)

- "...the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation..."
- A. <u>Pointing to Jesus Christ</u> (John 5:39)
- B. <u>Pointing to Faith in Him (Romans 10:17)</u>
- V. <u>Scripture Profits the Student of its Pages</u> (v. 16)
 - A. <u>Doctrine</u> (1 Timothy 4:15-16) Basic teachings/foundational truths.
 - **B.** <u>**Reproof**</u> God telling you when you are wrong.
 - **C.** <u>**Correction**</u> God steering you in the right direction.
 - **D.** <u>Instruction in Righteousness</u> God showing you what you need to know to live righteously.
- VI. <u>Scripture Perfects the Servant of the Lord</u> (v. 17)
 - A. <u>This Perfection is a Process</u> (Philippians 3:10-14)
 - B. <u>This Perfection is a Possibility</u> (Philippians 3:15)
- VII. <u>Scripture Produces Fruit in the Saint</u> (v. 17) "...throughly furnished unto all good works."
 - A. <u>It Fills "thoroughly</u>" (Colossians 3:16)
 - B. <u>It Furnishes "furnished</u>" (Titus 1:9)
 - C. <u>It Finishes "all good works</u>" (1 Thessalonians 2:13)
