A One-Time Event for Old Testament Israelites (Ezra 10:1-3)

- Put away your strange wives, and such as are born of them (vs 3).
- This passage cannot be used by New Testament Christians to justify divorce.

THE FOUNDATION FOR GOD'S ESTABLISHMENT OF MARRIAGE: "FROM THE BEGINNING."

- 1. **Psalm 119:160** God's word is true **from the beginning**.
- 2. 1 John 1:1-2 with John 1:1 Jesus Christ (the Word) is God and has been from the beginning.
- 3. Mark 10:6-9 God established marriage between a man and a woman from the beginning.
 - To reject what the bible says about marriage is as significant as rejecting the deity of Christ and the truth of the word of God.
 - A society that rejects what God says is a proper relationship between a man and a woman is a society that will also reject what the bible says about Jesus Christ and then will reject all that the bible says about everything else.
 - o If the bible isn't true, what authority forbids adultery, fornication, and perversions?
 - o If Jesus isn't God, why would anybody listen to what He tells them to do?
 - A society that permits adultery, fornication, and premarital relations is a society that has clearly rejected Jesus Christ and the bible.
- 4. Matthew 19:4 God "made them at the beginning...male and female."
 - If you don't believe in God and you reject the bible, you're free to create transgenders, nogenders, and LGBTQ's. When you dismiss God, anything goes.
- 5. **Matthew 19:8-9 "from the beginning"** God's intention was that the man and woman who were joined never separate.
 - When man's heart grows hard against God, the result is broken marriages and families.
- 6. **Matthew 19:5** Marriage is more important than parentage or lineage.
- 7. Mark 10:7-9 "For this cause..." This is the key. What is the cause? What is the reason you are to cleave to your spouse? Verse 6 "From the beginning of the creation God made them male and female."
 - When you divorce, you are rejecting God.
 - The cause is not that your marriage is so important, but because God is so important.
 - o If you reject God on something as major as marriage, you'll reject Him on everything.
- 8. **Ephesians 5:31-33** Staying married is so important because it is a picture of Christ and the Church.
 - People today don't want to trust the Heavenly Father because the only father they ever knew deserted them and their mother.
 - When you tell people Jesus will never leave them or forsake them, they're not going to believe you. That's what their dad said to their mom at the altar.
 - Your marriage is a very important example to others of true faithfulness.
- 9. **Hebrews 13:4** "Marriage is honourable in all..." That means in all the relationships a person might consider, marriage is the only one that is honorable.

- "...and the bed undefiled." It defiles you to be in a bed with someone you're not married to.
- "...but whoremongers and adulterers God will judge."
 - The bible teaches that you will reap what you sow. You must reject God and the bible if you don't believe God will judge you—because you're you. No exceptions.
- 10. First Corinthians 6:13 God didn't make your body for fornication. He made it for Himself.
 - Fornication is a violation of what God made your body for. You must reject God first before proceeding to fornicate.
 - You can't expect to have a good marriage if your starting point was a rejection of God.
- 11. **First Corinthians 5:9-13** God commands us to not keep company with fornicators. They must not be allowed to remain in fellowship while they are rejecting God and defiling their bed.

THE MARRIAGE RELATIONSHIP

- 12. Ephesians 5:22-33
 - "22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord."
 - The reason wives have difficulty submitting is because their husband is nothing like the Lord.
 - "23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church..."
 - o The church is not obedient to Christ. Nevertheless He continues to love His church.
 - Husbands should not withhold love from the wife even if she won't submit.
 Don't put conditions on your love.
 - "24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so *let* the wives *be* to their own husbands in every thing."
 - It is easy to trust Christ and subject ourselves to Him because He is worthy of our trust. He has never let us down.
 - It is more difficult for a wife to submit to a husband because he can't always be trusted.
 - "25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it."
 - o Everything Christ gave up was for your benefit. He did not gain anything from it.
 - He didn't complain about what it cost Him.
 - o Husbands gripe about how much their wife has cost them. They are selfish.
 - **26-27** Christ's Church has spots, blemishes, wrinkles, and "any such thing," yet He never lets that change who He is. He never stops loving His church through many imperfections.
 - o If a man is like Christ, he will love his wife in every stage of their life together.
 - 28-30 "So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies."
 - o Don't love them only when they love you (Luke 6:32,1 Peter 2:20-23).
 - Deny yourself and put the other person first (Mat. 16:24, Php 2:3-4).
 - 31-33 "let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence *her* husband."
 - Don't lower your standards once you're married. Earn the respect of your spouse by continuing to be just as respectful as you were when you were dating.
