Seeing is Believing...Or is it? 1 Kings 10:1-7

I. THOSE WHO BELIEVE NOT BECAUSE THEY SEE NOT

- a. They claim they would believe if they saw (Mark 15:31-32)
- b. They require signs and wonders in order to believe (John 4:48)
 - i. They have already rejected what they have been shown (John 6:14, 30)
 - ii. They will not be given signs and wonders (Matthew 12:38-40)

II. THOSE WHO SEE BUT BELIEVE NOT

- a. They use any excuse to reject the truth (John 6:28-36)
- b. They are like the brethren of the rich man (Luke 16:27-31)

III. THOSE WHO SEE AND BELIEVE

- a. They are touched by what they see (Lamentations 3:51; John 11:45)
- b. They are convinced by what they see (John 20:24-29)
- c. They believe the Son and receive eternal life (John 6:40)
 - **i.** We see the Son (spiritually) by reading the scriptures. No one will see Jesus physically on earth until the Second Advent (**Matthew 24:23-27**).

IV. THOSE WHO BELIEVE WITHOUT SEEING

- a. The special blessing on those who believe without seeing (John 20:29)
- b. The special response of those who believe without seeing (1 Peter 1:7-8)
 - i. A special love for Christ
 - ii. A special joy in faith
- c. Their special reliance on the word of God
 - i. The unbelief of the disciples (Mark 16:14)
 - ii. The faith based on the word of God (Romans 10:13-17)

V. THOSE WHO SEE BECAUSE THEY BELIEVE

- a. Those who believe will see the glory of God (John 11:40)
- b. Those who believe will see Him who is invisible (Hebrews 11:27)
- c. Those who believe—to see—will be strengthened (Psalm 27:13-14)
